Each of the following judgment criteria will be taken into account.

Pronunciation:

- Clear pronunciations
- Proper pronunciation of guttural, cerebral etc.
 - i.e. differentiate between 't' and 't'; 'd' and 'd'; 'n' and 'n' etc.
- Proper pronunciation of alpaprana and mahaprana
 - i.e. differentiate between 't' and 'th'; 'd' and 'dh' etc.
- Proper pronunciation of aspirate (visarga)
- Proper pronunciation of nasal
- Proper breaking of sandhi at end of a quarter

Chanting Style:

- Chanting v/s reciting like prose

Memory:

- Fluency in chanting
- Need for prompting
- Request for picking another set of verses

Overall Presentation:

- Posture
